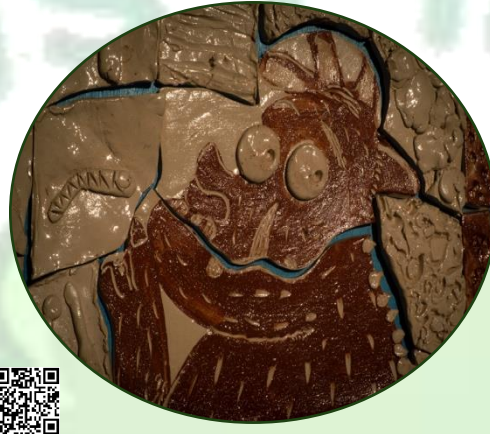

When you walk into school don't forget to look at these clay panels of different books that were made by children at school with Jon the Potter. What books can you find?



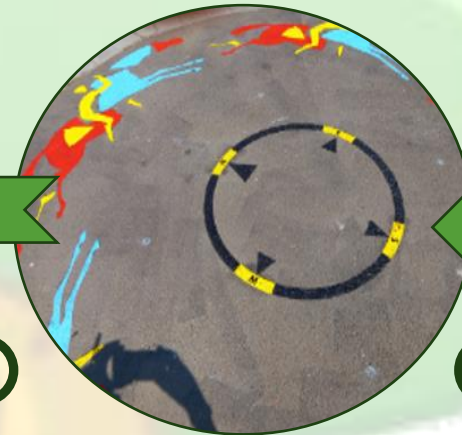
Walk along All Saints Road and cross over to visit the Norton Museum for collections of old artefacts and artwork from around the Bromsgrove.
