



# Year 3 Summer Term 1

## Science

We begin our summer term exploring the wonderful world of plants. We will identify the parts of flowering plants and learn how flowering plants produce seeds for future growth. We will be growing our own Sunflower plant and investigating what plants need in order to grow well. We will conduct an experiment to learn how water is transported through a plant and learn the different ways seeds disperse ready for growing.



## English

As usual we will be doing a mixture of fiction and non-fiction work this half term. We will be reading about Boudicca, the Celtic warrior queen who fought against the invading Romans. We'll use our research skills to find out about the well organised and successful Roman Army. We will also be writing stories and will finish with some creative poetry, writing about volcanos - inspired by events in Pompeii.



## History

We will be picking up where we left Britain in Autumn 1 with the Romans and how they came to become such a powerful, global empire. We will debate key figures such as Julius Caesar and Emperor Claudius and explore how Britain rebelled with Boudicca at the helm.

Much of our time will be spent outside practising athletics as well as learning some striking and fielding games, such as rounders and tri-golf.



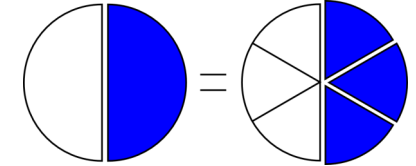
**French** The new vocabulary for this half term include the French words family members, pets and everyday objects.
