Phonics

This week we have been very pleased with the children as they have been reading and writing words containing blends. Blends continue to be the main focus next week and we will be reading and writing words with 2 blends such as 'shelf' and 'munch'

Reading

In addition to the weekly book you receive from school, there are a wider range of ebooks available from the e-Collins website—please speak to your class teacher if you need any support accessing the ebooks.

Maths—This week we have been exploring more complex patterns. We began by looking at physical patterns (e.g. clap hands, clap hands, tap your head), before exploring shape patterns and sequences later in the week. Next week we will be exploring numbers to 20 and beyond.

The children are very excited about starting their balanceability sessions. Unfortunately we have had to push our starting point back a couple of weeks for reasons beyond our control.
