The Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)

The EYFS is a <u>play-based</u> curriculum – following on from Nursery, with a balance of both **adult** and **child-initiated** tasks

There are 7 areas of learning. All have EQUAL importance;

The Prime Areas: PSED, PD, CL



These areas of learning are developed and taught inside and in the outside classroom, through child and adult led activities







Specific Areas: covers reading, phonics, maths, science, art etc...

We follow the phonics programme called **little wandle** and we will be holding a phonics meeting in the autumn term.




Please hear your child read or share a book EVERY day !
