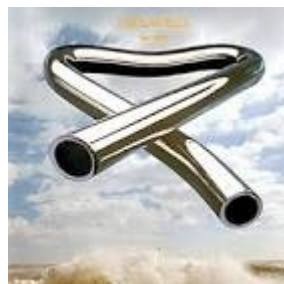
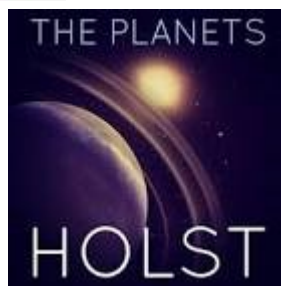

Pulse	The steady beat of the music, like a heart beat

Percussion	The striking or tapping of a musical instrument to
