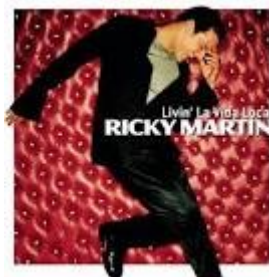

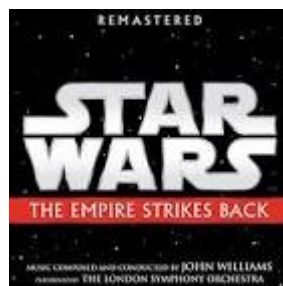


Key Composers and listening

Key Vocabulary	Definition
Pulse	The steady beat of the music, like a heart beat
Rhythm	The pattern of the words, combinations of long and short sounds.
Pitch	How high or low a sound is.
Improvise	To make up a tune and play it on the spot that will probably never be played exactly the same again.
Compose	To create and develop musical ideas and 'fix' them.
Percussion	The striking or tapping of a musical instrument to produce sounds.
Bossa Nova	A Brazilian dance music that has syncopated guitar rhythms.
