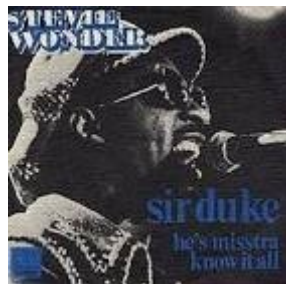
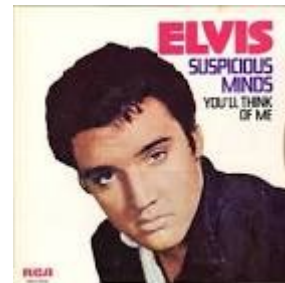
Key Composers and listening

Key Vocabulary	Definition
Pulse	The steady beat of the music, like a heart beat
Rhythm	The pattern of the words, combinations of long and short sounds.
Pitch	How high or low a sound is.
Dynamics	How quietly or loud music is played.
Improvise	To create sounds freely without preparation.
Tempo	The speed at which a piece of music is played.
Rap	Rhyme or rhythmic speech which is chanted over a backing beat or musical accompaniment.
