P.S.H.E. We will explore different emotions and how these are expressed. We will also focus on building positive relationships and being yourself.

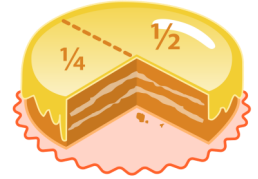
French This half term we will be revisiting all the French words covered so far and using these in conversation with each other.

Maths

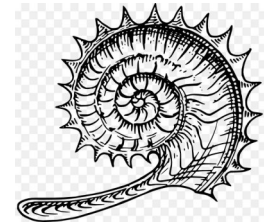
