I can name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and surrounding seas.

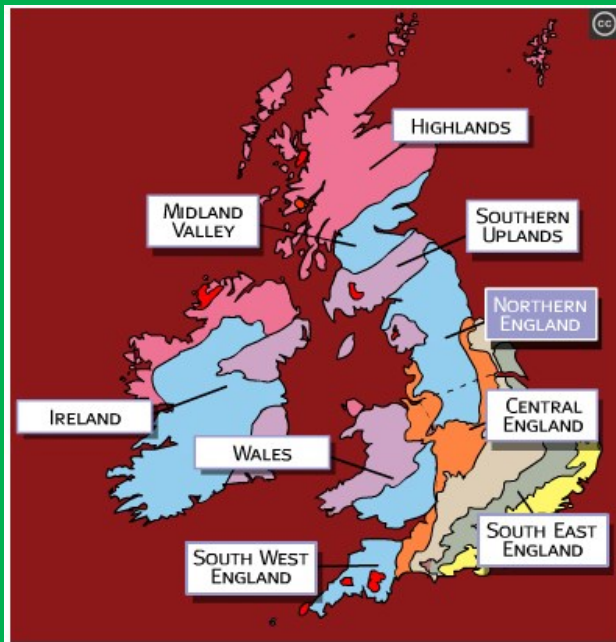
I can use an atlas and globe to locate land and sea and to name and locate UK and major features.

Word/ term	definition
Agriculture	The process of cultivating land to grow crops and rearing animals for food
City	A large town like London or Birmingham
Coast	Where the land meets the sea
Compass point	Any of the main points on a compass: North, South, East, West
County	A county is a specific region/area of a country.
Country	An area of land that is controlled by its own government
Erosion	from Latin erosionem meaning "a gnawing away,"
Human features	features of land that have been impacted by human activity
Physical features	natural features of land
Settlement	A place where people establish a community

Location of rocks:

- Igneous rocks - upland areas in Scotland, Lake District in North West England, Snowdonia in North Wales and Northern Ireland.
- Metamorphic rocks - Northern Ireland and Scotland.
- Sedimentary rocks - across lowland areas of southern and central parts of England.
