



Key techniques



collage/ printing Allow children time to explore printing and painting on top of tissue paper/ paper – when dry cut into shapes to use for own art



work.
The idea is to experiment and explore with paint colour and then use this for collage pictures

From last term – experiment with printing techniques (object printing/ mono printing to build up effects – use a range of objects to print on top of papers – such as bubble wrap/ corks/ sponges/ leaves etc)

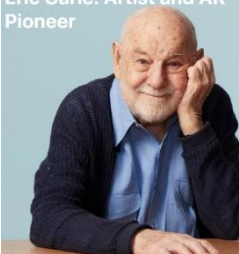


Key Vocabulary

Key Vocabulary	Definition
printing	Using objects and paint to make patterns and marks on paper
collage	Using papers/ materials and sticking them to make a picture/ or to explore art
layering	Building up a picture by using papers or other media on top of other papers (eg plant on top of tissue paper)
Mixed media	Using lots of media and materials to explore – eg paint and collage and printing to create your own art

Prior Learning

They will have explored different materials freely, developed ideas to use them, what to make/ explored different textures. They will have developed their own ideas deciding which materials to use to express them.
