 For their homework children will need to write some sentences describing the picture using their new vocabulary they learnt this week.

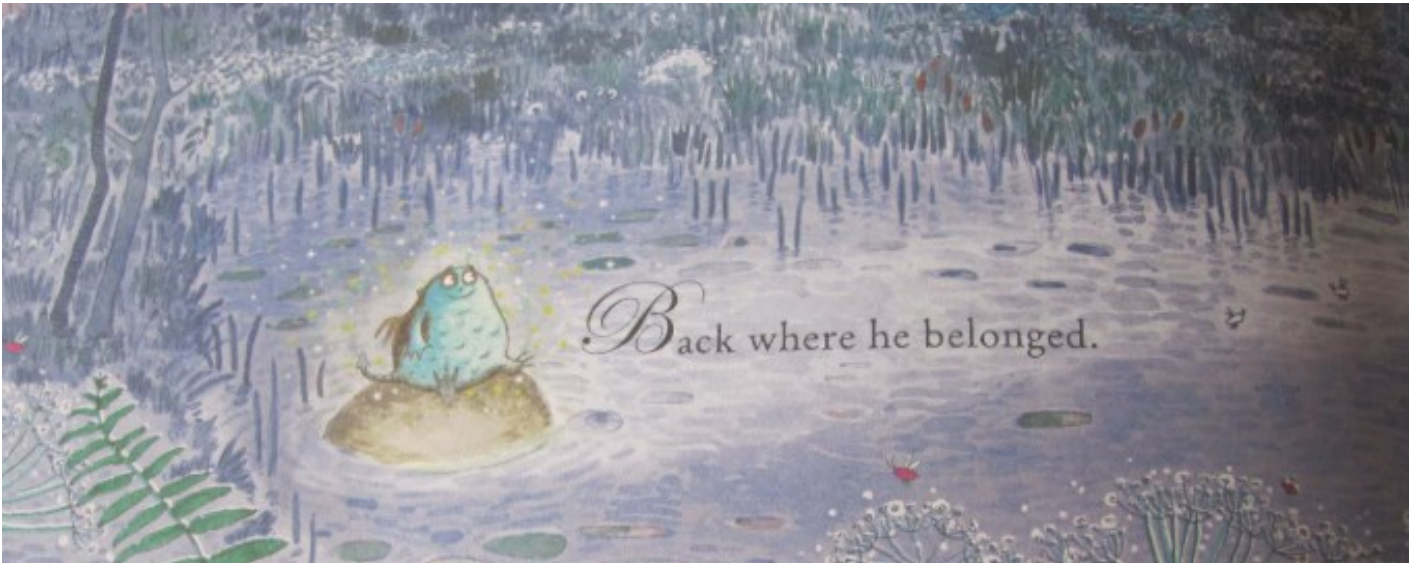


<p><b>Reading Records</b></p>	<p>We will check reading records on a Monday but children should bring these to school every day.</p>
