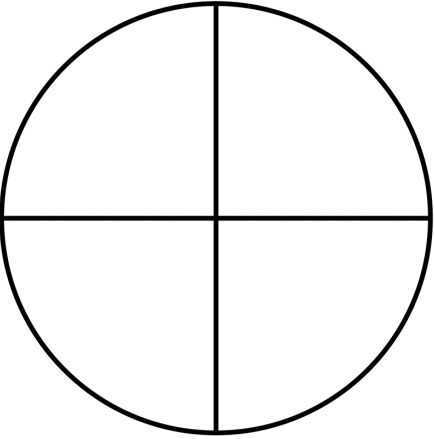

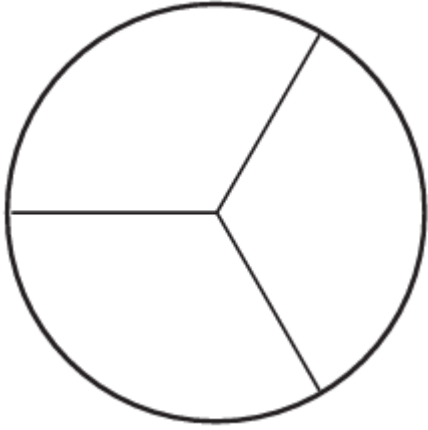
Colour $\frac{1}{2}$ of this pattern.



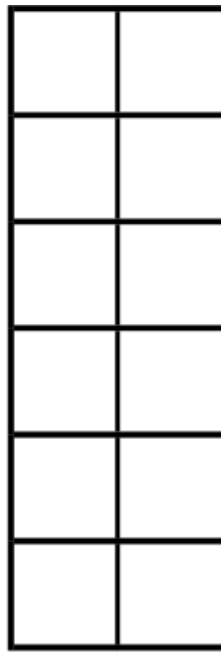
Colour $\frac{1}{4}$ of this pattern.



Colour $\frac{1}{3}$ of this pattern.

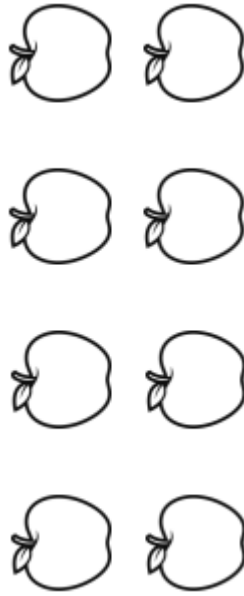


Colour $\frac{1}{2}$ of this pattern.



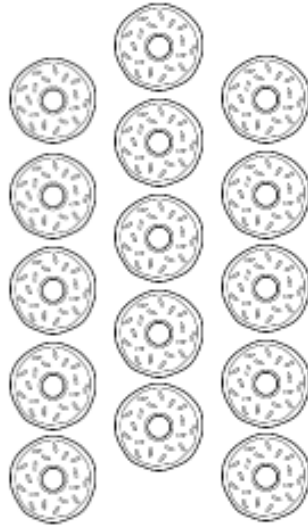
