


Use this website to help you or books at home if you have them.  <a href="https://www.researchify.co.uk/">https://www.researchify.co.uk/</a></p> <p>Although the website provided should only bring up child friendly links we always recommend children be supervised by an adult when searching anything online.</p> <p>Create a poster or a fact file. Which dinosaur is the heaviest, tallest? Which lived the longest, shortest time? <b>Tuesday</b>	<p>Children can create their own dinosaur bone art using cotton buds, straws, paper, pasta or anything else they can get their hands on.</p> 
<b>Wednesday</b>	<p><b>Handwriting-</b></p> <p>Practise your handwriting. Can you write a list of dinosaur names and practise the correct spelling?</p> 
<b>Thursday</b>	<p>Read or watch the story <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=tfv9GLmaUM">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=tfv9GLmaUM</a></p> <p>Use purplemash (2simple to paint) or ipad to draw a dinosaur, You can download a template of a dinosaur and fill in patterns/ colours to create your own design. Even better make up your own dinosaur and draw it. Make a story to go with it? Make a jumbled dinosaur collage: Collect some dinosaur pictures and make a collage of these pictures – by adding the eyes of one dinosaur/ the head of another/ the body of a different dinosaur etc</p> 
<b>Friday</b>	<p><b>Wellbeing Time-</b> Do something that relaxes you! We know some of you love to colour.</p> <p>Colour by numbers can be great fun! Build something with Lego (choose something from the 30 day Lego challenge) or use other kits. You could even have a go at some yoga.</p>

## Build-a-Dino Activity




Cut out and use the shapes to build us!




