

Bowl

Spoon





Glue

Newspaper

Cube

Wool

- 1) Blow up the balloon until it is huge.
- 2) Mix up the glue in a bowl. Use a spoon.
- 3) Put strips of newspaper into the glue then smooth them over the balloon.
- 4) Leave to dry then pop the balloon.
- 5) Attach the cube with the wool.
- 6) Paint any hue. Blue looks super cool.
