

# Flower Art & Craft



**Make your own paper and then press flowers onto it!**

Rip up newspaper or egg cartons into small pieces and then pour water over them.

You will need to soak them over night.

Then blend them well into a pulp.

Place it into a ball and onto a piece of cloth and roll out thinly. Place some heavy weights on top and allow to dry out completely

Now you can use your paper to put pressed flowers onto. Or you can sprinkle flower petals into the paper pulp before rolling it out.



## salt dough flower ornaments:

- Make some salt dough (recipe - 1 cupful of plain flour (about 250g)
- half a cupful of table salt (about 125g)
- half a cupful of water (about 125ml)

Mix well together and make into a ball. Roll out thinly. Press some flowers/ leaves into the dough to leave an imprint (do not leave them in!) – now bake very slowly on a very low heat. When dry paint!
