Please ensure your child brings a coat everyday as the weather is so changeable at the moment.

We are moving on from our initial text and are now focussing on 'Owl Babies' linked to family, belonging and transition. We will continue to build upon listening and attention skills and the children have enjoyed exploring sounds, songs and rhymes. We are also expecting some 'eggciting' new arrivals in the next week or so.

Thank you to everyone who is accessing tapestry and to those of you that are sharing photos from home, we really do enjoy talking about them during our whole class discussions. I will be adding home learning ideas and activities too. This can be used if you need to isolate due to Coronavirus symptoms or in addition to the provision within Nursery.

Symptoms of coronavirus in children

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot, for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- a loss or change to sense of smell or taste – this means they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

If your child has any of the main symptoms of coronavirus:

1. Get a test to check if they have coronavirus as soon as possible.
2. Stay at home and do not have visitors until you get the test result – only leave your home to have a test.
