We are delighted with how your children are progressing in learning their phonic digraphs. During an online course, it was emphasised how important it is for every child to crack the phonics code during their time in Year 1 to be able to read and spell well. The key to their success is recognising and being able to read all the sounds which make up our spoken language in English. Please rehearse the phase 3 and phase 5 phonemes with your children to ensure their success. When reading, encourage your child to read fluently the words they know and sound out any words which they don't know at once.

This week we have been learning about place value in maths. Perhaps your child could count the coins in their money box, counting the 10p's and then the ones to reinforce this skill.




For the week:	To Do
