Wow, what an unexpected year we have had so far, we are looking forward to embracing some routine and a new 'normal' as we welcome a new group of Ducklings to Meadows. We hope the children settle into their sessions well, we have been so excited to meet you all. We operate an open-door policy which means that the teachers are there to greet you in the mornings, they can chat briefly in the mornings – but if you need a longer chat, then please use the methods outlined above.

We send out regular Nursery newsletters to keep you updated, alongside weekly whole school newsletters, with information and dates relating to the wider school. These are posted on the school website or you can pick up a hard copy outside the school office. We do try to keep you informed as much as possible through our school website and Tapestry, so please keep yourselves familiar with these.

During the first few weeks of term we will be exploring 'friendly me' As part of Meadow's wellbeing wheel. Our key text for the term will be 'A bit lost' by Chris Haughton and 'All are Welcome' by Alexandra Penfold. We will be encouraging listening and attention skills and will begin to explore the first of our letters and sounds activities. We will be scaffolding numbers within their child-initiated play, with particular focus on 'one' and 'lots'. The children will also be exploring size (big and small).


In addition to our whole class paper-based learning journey, we use an online platform to document learning, this is called 'Tapestry' enabling us to collect evidence of your child's progress in Nursery through photographs and observations and to share these with you. We encourage you to use this and send us in your photographs and 'special' moments from home too.

We would recommend that the children come to school in clothing appropriate for the outdoors as we will be spending lots of time in our outdoor provisions. We would also ask that all children have a **named pair** of wellies that stay in school, as we do go out in all weathers. As the weather begins to turn please send your child to school with a named coat every day too. **Please name all clothing and shoes to avoid misplacing these.**

Please ensure you let a member of the Nursery Team know if someone else will be collecting at the end of the day, to ensure home time can run smoothly. Thank you for your patience as we adjust to a new one-way system when arriving and leaving Nursery. Please enter school through the back gate along the service road, turn left and come through both the Reception and Nursery Gardens, dropping off your child at the Nursery door. Then leave through the Nursery gate.

We do not have a packed lunch policy in place, however, we are a healthy school and encourage a balanced lunchbox. We ask that no nut-based products are included in packed lunches due to allergies in school and that any grapes or cherry tomatoes are cut lengthways to avoid the risk of choking. We will update you if any other allergies within the class come to light. Please ensure all lunchboxes and water bottles are clearly and permanently named.
