At school, we are really focused on the skill of letter formation and number formation. In Year 1 it is important for the children to correct themselves if they make a reversal error. With letters, b and d are the most common reversal, so make a bed with your thumbs, to remember thinking of the word 'bed'. Also 's, e, g and p' are also confused. Number reversals are very common as well because it is tricky to remember which way to go but all of the numbers begin at the top.


HOMEWORK We have sent a number and letter hand writing sheet home for your child to complete for homework this week and a sticker will be given on its return.


