Hello Year 1 Containing: Weekly spellings and homework.

The children have worked hard this week and are beginning to settle into their new routines. Please help your child by remembering to send their bookbag each day so that they can change their reading book to earn stickers. The children are not required to read the same book 3 times in Year One (they can if they wish).

Children in Year 1 have access to the Numbots Maths Game. Your child's Login can be found in the front of your child's reading record book. Numbots encourages children to improve their recall and fluency in subitising numbers (saying how many without counting), number bonds (mental recall) and adding and subtracting (known facts). Playing a few minutes each day will support your child's learning at school.
