## Maths

**Alive in 5** – Have understanding of 0, compare numbers to 5, represent numbers to 5, explore composition of numbers to 5, subitise with numbers to 5. Use the language of heavy, heavier than, heaviest, light, lighter than, lightest to compare items which have an obvious difference in weight. Build on their understanding of full and empty to show half full, nearly full and nearly empty.

**Growing 6,7,8** - apply the counting principles when counting to 6, 7 and 8. Represent 6, 7, and 8 in different ways and count out the required number of objects from a larger group. Explore composition of 6,7 and 8. Explore the concept of "pairs". Begin to combine 2 groups (addition). Use specific mathematical vocabulary to compare lengths. Use the part, part whole method Use the vocabulary 'yesterday', 'today' and 'tomorrow' to describe when events happen. Use the vocabulary of time to discuss events in their own lives.
