Knowledge /Skills:

Make sense of belief:

- Identify some Hindu deities and say how they help Hindus describe God
- Make clear links between some stories (e.g. Svetaketu, Ganesh, Diwali) and what Hindus believe about God
- Offer informed suggestions about what Hindu murtis express about God

Understand the impact:

- Make simple links between beliefs about God and how Hindus live (e.g. choosing a deity and worshiping at a home shrine)
- Identify some different ways in which Hindus worship linked to pilgrimage.

Make connections:

- Raise questions and suggest answers about whether it is good to think about the cycle of create/preserve/destroy in the world today.
- Make links between the Hindu idea of everyone having a 'spark' of God in them and ideas about the value of people in the world today, giving good reasons for their ideas.

Avatar	A deity that comes down to Earth in human form.
Aum	The most sacred symbol in Hinduism.
Brahman	The concept of God in Hinduism.
Deity	A a powerful spirit that controls events and the nature of things.
Devi	Devi is the word for "goddess" in Hinduism.
Diwali	One of the India's biggest festivals. It is a festival of lights and every Indian celebrates it with joy.
Durga	One of the goddesses in Hinduism.
Krishna	He is worshipped as the eighth avatar of the god Vishnu.
Lakshmi	Lakshmi is the goddess of money and good luck.
Parvati	Parvati is the wife of Shiva. Parvati is thought of as a mother goddess by many people.
Puja	It is a prayer service ritual performed by Hindus.
Rama	Rama is the Avatar of Vishnu in Hinduism. He was a king of ancient India.
Saraswati	She is the goddess of speech, learning and knowledge.
Shiva	Shiva is known as the destroyer God because he removes all evil from the world.
Vishnu	Vishnu is the preserver god, which means he protects the Earth.
