Key Vocabulary:

Labelling parts of the body

Head, eyes, mouth, nose, ears, neck, arm, hand, fingers, elbow, chest, stomach/tummy, leg, foot, toes, baby, toddler, teenager, adult, elderly, taste, smell, touch, hearing, sight.



Key activities / information/ key questions



- Name simple parts of the body
- Name features on a face (similarities and differences)
- Have an understanding of 'growing up' from baby to grandparents (linked to family experiences)
- Understand healthy food choices and how to keep themselves healthy (such as teeth brushing)

Prior/future knowledge:

Nursery:

Children will know about growing up and differences between what a baby can do/ child/ adult. They will recognize and talk about pictures that show different ages. They will know and name simple parts of the body and how to keep healthy. They will notice differences and similarities.

Future learning: Year 1

Children will reinforce their knowledge of body parts – labelling and identifying and naming all of the senses.
