Our maths focus next week will be on using and applying positional vocabulary.

We have spent a lot of time this week discussing the need for hygiene. Hand washing has been a big feature within both classes. We have discussed singing happy birthday twice while rubbing soap into hands. All children have been encouraged to wash hands after sneezing and coughing and to cough into their elbow. The children must be independent in blowing and wiping their own noses. Soap and tissues are available to all the children.
