We have a busy time planned for the last week of this half term. We are keeping our fingers crossed for good weather, which we hope lasts for the May bank holiday too.

Art: The Voices and Visions art display will be in Worcester Cathedral from Sunday 22nd May. As part of our Jubilee celebrations, Year 3 and year 4 will have an artist in residence working with them. This will be to work on some printing techniques. The whole school will also be working with Jon the Potter later in the year to create a clay celebration of the jubilee too.

We have organised a first aid workshop for each KS2 class on Monday 27th June as part of their PSHE curriculum. It is being run by 'Flat Stan First Aid' and the workshops have been designed specifically for children. We feel that it is important for children to be introduced to these essential life skills.



Next week we are celebrating the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. We have organised:
